We have several organizations waiting for blankets as the cold weather is here. At our meetings, January 2025 we will be making the Jar Blocks and Fleece Blankets and February 2025 we will be making Quilt Kits.

Monthly meetings are for dropping off finished blankets. See the blankets that are donated & help sew a Project Linus label on each blanket before the blankets are donated. Meet the volunteers. We are always in need of new fabric, fleece, or yarn. Donations must be arranged with the Chapter Coordinator before the donation is delivered.

JOANN STORE DROP OFF'S – No Double Layer Fleece
ONLY NEW HANDMADE BLANKETS CAN BE DROPPED OFF AT JOANN'S in unscented bags with your contact information.

At the **January 2025 Meetings**, we will be making "Something in a Jar". The fabric for the jar fabric should be 5 ½ inches by 9 inches & anything can be in jar. You will bring 20 "jars" and exchange if you wish 10 of your "jars" for 10 "jars" in the Project Linus Stash. You do not have to exchange "jar" fabric. Bring 1 yard of fabric for the sashing and cornerstones on the jars. The sashing will be 2 1/2 inches or whatever size you want. We will also be making no sew fleece blankets.

At the **February 2025 Meetings**, we will be making Quilt Kits, bring your cutting/measuring tools.

Detailed information about each meeting is sent out in the monthly emails.

We are not accepting rag quilts or double fleece blankets. We cannot accept any blankets that have been washed or dried in scented products or donated in scented bags. The scent is picked up by the fabric & yarn & can be dangerous to a child. Before turning ANY of your blankets in or sewing labels on the blankets, please exam them very, very carefully for pins.

If you are <u>donating blankets at the monthly meetings & not staying</u>, blankets must be brought into the meeting in an unscented bag with your name & contact information in the bag & given to the Chapter Coordinator. They are not to be put out on the tables to be labeled or dropped off at the sign in table.

1 1/3 TO 1 ½ YARDS LONG BY THE WIDTH OF THE FABRIC If you have any questions, please contact the chapter coordinator at oclinus@ptd.net PLEASE NOTE: All other blankets should be between 40 inches & 48 inches wide & up to 56 inches in length.

- WE ARE IN NEED OF INFANT THEME BLANKETS THAT ARE 40 INCHES BY 40 TO 48 INCHES IN LENGTH.
